What to Bring:

- Bible (put in a large zip-loc bag)

- Toiletries (Toothbrush, Shampoo, Deodorant)
- Rain Gear or Windbreaker jacket (optional)
- Fishing Pole (optional)
- Money - to purchase items at the canteen, Wapo store, arts & crafts, for e-mails from parents, or a DVD at the end of the week for \$8.00.
- JOC (8th graders) at Ox Lake need a reliable bicycle & helmet

What NOT to Bring

- Cell Phones
- Electronic devices including iPods, Game Boys, etc.
- Lighters/ matches
- Weapons of any sort
- Knives of any kind
- Fireworks
- Non-prescription drugs
- Illegal drugs or Alcohol
